Lake Management: Wheaton reported that first milfoil treatment was 20 sites on 16 acres. Ruth Lake and Mickey Lake have responded well to past treatment. Next treatment is July 30. Lishawa reported on NMC lake studies. Klein reported on progress of swimmers itch study. Initial snail samples have been taken. Hewitt presented information on boat washing options to help prevent invasive species.

Water Safety: Kraimer stated sheriff department has not indicated any problems.

Fishing Quality/Loon Management: Motley reported on perch and walleye fishing. Fish survey data is not yet complete. He stated there were 6 loon nest sites on the lake. Brush Island nest was abandoned with 3 eggs. There are 4 chicks this year.

Communications and Website: Kiehle asked for members to submit info for power point presentation for August meeting

Membership: Dow reported we have 289 paid to date memberships and reminders will be sent. She asked for suggestions for nominees for vacant board positions.

Recreation/Social: Dow reported 166 people attended Welcome Back to Paradise this year, which is an increase from the past two years. She has sent thank you notes to Boones staff.

Community Affairs: Zirnhelt reported on township budget for parks

Island Maintenance: Lemcool reported some tree maintenance had been done.
