Lake Management: Jim Wheaton reported on milfoil treatments for 2018. Zero Gravity will do drone mapping of weed beds and provide data for analysis and treatment.

Fishing and Loons: Terry Motley reported loon nesting is 3-4 weeks behind schedule this year. Results from the DNR fish survey are forthcoming. Early fishing has been good. Thanks given to individuals who manage loon nesting platforms.

Island Maintenance: Walt Kraimer gave updates on island docks, restrooms and trails. He thanked Dan Marks for his work on these projects.

Water Safety: Walt Kraimer reported on swimming safety; wake damage, marine patrol and various Michigan boating laws.

Community Affairs: Karen Rosa thanked LLF and LLA for partnering with the township. She gave updates on the new Crescent Shores boat launch and grant

monies received to help with the UA trail at the Timbers property. June 30 is proposed date for fireworks, rain date, July 1. Fire chief Andy Down reported on the number of calls in the township, ISO scores for home insurance and future fire dept. purchases. Millage renewal for fire service up for vote in August.
